RE: Proposed rule revisions

Attached to this e-mail, is our proposed rule revisions to Washington's Radiological Health Rules to adopt the following RATS:

- 2001-1, Requirements for certain generally licensed industrial devices containing byproduct material;
- 2007-2, Exemptions from licensing, general licenses and distribution of byproduct material: licensing and reporting requirements; and
- 2012-1, Change of compatibility of 10 CFR 31.5 and 31.6.

This rulemaking changes three of our chapters:

- Chapter 246-232 WAC, Radioactive material – licensing applicability;
- Chapter 246-333 WAC, Radioactive materials – general licenses; and
- Chapter 246-235 WAC, Radioactive materials – specific licenses.

To give NRC time to review the proposed rule revisions, we are sending them to you early. We anticipate sending the proposed revisions to our stakeholders in June 2013 for public comment. We request NRC's comments by July 1, 2013.

For language or punctuation we are deleting, it has a solid line through it and new language or punctuation is underlined.

We believe these proposed rule revisions satisfies the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Programs (FSME) Procedure SA-200.
