TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY (TVA) - SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT (SQN) -  
CONSTRUCTION STORM WATER GENERAL PERMIT (CGP) TRACKING NO.  
TNR191316 - NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO REDUCE INSPECTION FREQUENCY

TVA is submitting this letter to serve as written notification of the intent to reduce inspection frequency for all temporarily stabilized areas covered under the subject permit. Construction activity is nearing completion and the site is currently in the process of establishing perennial vegetation of all previously disturbed areas.

According to Section 3.5.8.2 of the CGP, where sites or portion(s) of construction sites have been temporarily stabilized, the inspection frequency may be reduced to once per month until construction activity resumes. TVA wishes to apply this provision for areas that have been temporarily stabilized but have not yet established permanent vegetation.

For definable areas that have been finally stabilized, TVA will identify these areas on the SWPPP and note that no further inspections are required to that portion of the site. Once the overall facility has been finally stabilized, TVA will submit a notice of termination requesting coverage under the CGP for construction activity to be terminated.


