Dear Mr. Jones:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (Commission) has granted the enclosed Exemption and issued the enclosed Amendment No. 6 to Combined Licenses Nos. NPF-93 and NPF-94 for the Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station (VCSNS) Units 2 and 3, respectively. The amendment consists of changes to the updated final safety analysis report (UFSAR) for VCSNS Units 2 and 3 and Appendix C in response to your application dated August 29, 2012, and supplemented by letter dated February 11, 2013.

The exemption allows the implementation of changes to the UFSAR that depart from Tier 1 information in the AP1000 Certified Design Control Document as specified in License Amendment Request 12-01 and its supplement. The amendment adds four non-Class 1E electrical penetration assemblies and electrical penetration sleeves to the containment vessel and shield building.

A copy of the related Safety Evaluation, which includes the evaluation of the amendment and exemption, is also enclosed. The notice of issuance of the amendment and the exemption will be published in the *Federal Register*.
