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## General Comment

Please deny Strata a permit to mine uranium, in-situ, under Document ID NRC-2011-0148-007, until the over 5,000 abandoned drill holes from the early days of uranium exploration are cleaned up and plugged. There are over 1682 old holes in the Ross In-Situ area and Strata has only plugged 55. These old holes will facilitate water contamination if the current project is allowed to go forward. We must keep our water clean for the future. This will NOT be a "small" impact on the area if the water is contaminated. And contamination is irreversible once it occurs for many, many future generations. These old drill holes must be plugged correctly before any new permits are issued.

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
