To Whom It May Concern,

This letter is to request an Amendment to our NRC license 13-32738-01 registered to Bristol Myers Squibb Company (BMS). I am requesting that Greg Luff be removed from the license. Greg is listed in the address as the contact person; he is no longer employed with BMS.

I am also requesting that Susan (Nord) Blessinger be added to the list of our Authorized Users. I have attached a copy of her Bachelor's degree and her training record for your review.

Susan Blessinger has been employed with Bristol Myers Squibb since April, 2012. During that time, she has completed initial/annual Radiation Safety Training as required by our Environmental Health and Safety department as a user of radioactive materials. This training is a self-study Power Point presentation explaining radiation exposure, sources of radiation, and rules and regulations to follow established by the NRC as well as the Indiana State Board of Health. The presentation also stresses the need for radiation safety for all personnel as well as our responsibility to the public and to the environment.

Susan has received the required training of our RIA assay Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), including, but not limited to, training in the use of I 125, radiation inventory, and proper disposal of radioactive waste. She has implemented this training in performing required wipe tests upon receipt of RIA assay kits, documenting inventory of these kits, practicing safe handling of I 125 tracers, and in the proper disposal and storage of radioactive waste generated by her work. Training was provided by myself or other authorized users stated on our license. Susan has successfully completed and reported many RIA assays with management oversight since her hire date and has complied with all aspects of radiation safety.

In addition, Susan has had previous experience with education, training, and work with radiation as a Medical Technologist with GF1, a clinical pharmaceutical research contract laboratory in Evansville, IN. She performed many RIA assays while employed there from 1994-1998.

I am confident that Susan understands and takes very seriously her responsibility concerning radiation safety and I would ask that she be added to our list of Authorized Users on our NRC license for work at Bristol Myers Squibb.
