

The following is a summary of the licensed activities that EnergySolutions and the US Department of Agriculture will be responsible under their respective Radioactive Materials licenses during the BARC disposal site remediation project.

EnergySolutions


EnergySolutions shall be responsible for the following activities under the EnergySolutions mobile NRC Radioactive Materials D&D license, 06-20775-01:

- Implementation of the EnergySolutions Radiation Protection Program during site remediation,
- Training of project personnel,
- Coordinating and performing site remedial activities,
- Monitoring project personnel and the general public,
- Waste handling, segregation and packaging,
- Waste storage and shipment,
- Final Status Surveys and site restoration.

US Department of Agriculture

The US Department of Agriculture shall be responsible for the following activities under their NRC Radioactive Materials License 19-00915-03.

- Maintaining site security and access,
- General site access training,
- Oversight of EnergySolutions remediation work,
- Monitoring of US Dept. of Agriculture and oversight personnel
- Public relations.
