David,

I have spent some time reviewing the tie-down documents on the CRMI license. Based on my review, I have a number of items that need to be addressed:

1. This is what I believe to be the uses at each location. Please review and correct me if I have characterized any of them incorrectly.
Aibonito – 35.100; 35.200; 35.300 (including inpatient I-131 therapy treatments)
Cayey – 35.100; 35.200; 35.300 (outpatient I-131 therapy); 35.400
Caguas – 35.100; 35.200; 35.300 (outpatient I-131 therapy)
2. We are missing a letter concerning access for decommissioning for the Caguas site. I would like a letter similar to the one dated May 18, 2007 which was between CRMI and Mennonite General in Cayey.
3. According to the most recent inspection report there are written agreements between Mennonite, CRMI and TUROC that address each other's responsibilities regarding the conduct of licensed activities by CRMI and TUROC. Please provide a copy (English translation) of these agreements.

Please provide the above information within 30 days and I will complete the amendment to add the Caguas location of use.
