Mike,

You're right that the open site approach doesn't call for arranged lodging or transportation. However, I thought having the bus with a central pick-up location worked well for the last survey and helped ensure that we all arrived and started together each morning and stayed at the site until the end of the survey each day. If this is something you'd like to do again, I can let the THPOs know that you suggest doing this and removing those costs from the reimbursement. Alternatively, if you'd like to follow the open site approach as is, I can just provide each THPO with directions to the site from Moorcroft and Sundance and the time that the surveyors should arrive at the site in the morning and we'll go from there; I expect that there could be up to 7 vehicles carrying my team and the surveyors to the site each morning.
