Dear Mr. Welsh:

This concerns the subject application for an amendment to your material license. Your amendment requested the removal of the Pratt & Whitney Middletown facility from the license, and provided the Building 10 Decommissioning and Final Radiological Status Report. However, because activities with licensed materials occurred in other buildings in Middletown in the past, as well as the use of radioactive materials under a general license and the use of radioactive materials which do not require you to have a license, additional information about residual contamination and/or continued use of those materials in other buildings at Middletown is required. Because you informed us that you will not be able to supply the additional information required to complete the requested action for some time, we have voided your application. This action is taken without prejudice to the resubmission of your request.

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011. While a policy statement and not a regulation, it sets forth the agency's *expectations* for individuals and organizations to establish and maintain a positive safety culture.
