SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Dr. Chu:

In facsimile dated April 16, 2013, you contacted the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate NRC Materials License No. 24-32529-01 for Cardiology Associates Medical Group. The aforementioned fax included NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," supporting the decommissioning of your location at 19550 East 39th Street, Suite 220, Independence, Missouri. On May 21, 2013, I spoke with a former technologist of your group, Mr. Don Salisbury, by telephone and he confirmed that material had been properly transferred to Centerpoint Medical Center under NRC License No. 24-18655-01. Mr. Salisbury also provided a copy of the leak test reports for the sealed sources transferred or disposed of.

The NRC staff has reviewed all of this information, including your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.


Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility at 19550 East 39th Street, Suite 220, Independence, Missouri, is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC License No. 24-32529-01 is hereby terminated.
