In a letter dated February 23, 2013, Gregory H. Rogers, President of MidMichigan Medical Center – Midland, contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your byproduct materials license no. 21-03429-04, concurrent with the merger of this licensed program into the license for MidMichigan Medical Center and license no. 21-01549-02.

The NRC staff has reviewed your letter, including the attached Form NRC 314 dated February 20, 2013, and the letter from Gratiot Medical Center, dated February 19, 2013, signed by Mark Santamaria, President and CEO. Based on our review NRC license number 24-03429-04 is hereby terminated with the enclosed Amendment No. 19. The amendment adding Gratiot Medical Center's licensed program into the license for MidMichigan Medical Center is being sent separately to their management.
