SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 30-27555-02

By letter dated March 27, 2013, you informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license. The NRC Form 314 dated March 27, 2013, stated that all radioactive material had been transferred to your Agreement State license issued by the Agreement State of New Mexico. Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required.

Please find enclosed Amendment No. 1 to License No. 30-27555-02, authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(i or ii).
