In the amendment request, dated April 12, 2013, the licensee requested that License Condition 9 include "and trade shows." During an announced initial safety inspection at the Ijamsville, MD location on May 23, 2013, the inspector discussed the licensee's program and license with the RSO.

On June 10, 2013, I contacted the RSO to discuss standard language in License Condition 9, Authorized use. The inspector stated that using standard language "at temporary jobs sites" in License Condition 9 would be appropriate for the program. The RSO agreed.

The inspector also discussed with the RSO the option to combine their NRC License 06-31431-01 with NRC License 19-31474-01 to save the company an annual fee. The RSO stated that he would re-visit the subject during a future management meeting.

Lastly, the RSO asked what he would need to do in order to add servicing the IMS devices on one of their NRC licenses. I stated that he should follow the guidance in NUREG-1156, Vol. 18, and submit an amendment request to the NRC, including operating and emergency procedures. In addition, I mentioned to the RSO that the NRC License (19-31474-01) is in an agreement state (MD) and is a temporary job site license therefore servicing the IMS devices would not be authorized. The RSO stated that he understood and thanked me for my assistance.
