6/14/2013 (13:18) I left a message on the contact person's voice-mail number, i.e., 860-437-6748. The Practice Administrator was no longer Tracey Gomez-Johnson and I requested that someone get back in touch with me as the Federal license for the use of radioactive materials was expiring and no renewal application had been received.

6/17/2013 (09:00) I attempted to make contact with someone using the same phone number again. (10:30) I used the main number for Eastern Connecticut Cardiology Diagnostics and was informed that the RSO and the Practice Administrator were unavailable. The receptionist put me through to Ms. Phillips voice-mail so that I could leave a message. (15:50) Ms. Phillips returned my call. She indicated that the licensee has been trying to have the physicist draft a letter requesting that the cardiology license and the hospital license be combined. I examined the hospital license and saw that it authorized the main hospital and a PET facility in Suite 102 across from the cardiology office (Suite 103). I informed her that she was correct that the NRC needed something in writing to combine the licenses and that allowing the license to lapse would require a cessation of licensed activities. Ms. Phillips also inquired whether combining the licenses would void out the Annual Fee Notice that was received by the cardiology office. Since the Notice was for the FY 2013 period, I stated that the full fee would be required to be paid. Ms. Phillips stated that she would see to it that the request to combine the licenses was sent to the NRC by June 21, 2013.
