In letter dated March 25, 2013, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facilities located at 148 South Cedar Street, Lansing Michigan; and 3725 South Canal Road, Lansing, Michigan are suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 21-15860-01 is hereby terminated.
