Dear Mr. Nazar:

By letter to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) dated August 3, 2012 (Agencywide Documents Access and management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML12220A353), Florida Power & Light Company (the licensee) submitted Revision 15 of the physical security plan (PSP) for the Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Unit Nos. 3 and 4. The licensee provided this information in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Part 50, Section 54(p)(2). The enclosures to the letter contained safeguards information; therefore, the NRC withheld these enclosures from public disclosure.

By letter dated January 17, 2013 (ADAMS Accession No. ML13032A066), the licensee responded to the NRC staff's December 18, 2012, request for additional information (ADAMS Accession No. ML12341A159). The licensee's response provided sufficient information for the NRC to determine the adequacy of the changes to the PSP. In addition, the licensee committed to provide clarification in the following revision to the PSP, which it provided to the NRC by letter dated March 27, 2013 (ADAMS Accession No. ML13092A123). The enclosures to the letter contained safeguards information; therefore, the NRC withheld these enclosures from public disclosure. The NRC confirmed that the licensee incorporated the clarification into the PSP and met its commitment.

The NRC staff's review of the licensee's submittals consisted of determining whether the licensee properly concluded that changes to the PSP did not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the PSP. The NRC staff determined that the licensee properly concluded that the reported changes did not result in a decrease in safeguards effectiveness. The effectiveness of the implementation of the identified PSP revisions is subject to future NRC review and inspection.
