SUMMARY NRC participants: Chris Allen and Bernard White Department of Energy (DOE) participant: Marvin Bennett Idaho Engineering and Environmental Laboratory (INEEL) participant: Craig Tyler AREVA Federal Services, LLC participant: Richard Smith and Rick Migliore The call commenced at approximately 3:45 P.M. EST. INEEL initiated the conversation by stating that they wanted to ship fuel elements which were similar, if not identical, in design to allowed contents for the Advanced Test Reactor Fresh Fuel Shipping Container, but which did not have the same name as allowed contents in the certificate of compliance (CoC). However, they stated that the mass and enrichment of uranium-235 in these similar fuel elements were bounded by the Small Quantity Payload description on page 3 of the CoC. Staff suggested an amendment request to modify the allowed contents name within the CoC be submitted, and staff provided an approximate time frame in which a response could be expected. Inquiries into which portions of the Safety Analysis Report should be submitted in support of the name change amendment were made. Staff explained that, because Chapters 7 and 8 were incorporated by reference into the CoC, any pages within these chapters affected by the name change must be submitted as well as any drawings specified in the CoC which were affected by the name change. Staff also advised that, when a consolidated version of the Safety Analysis Report was submitted for renewal of the CoC, staff would ensure the name change was incorporated into Chapters 1 thru 6 even though these chapters need not be submitted in support of the amendment request. The call was subsequently concluded at approximately 4:15 P.M. EST.
