The NRC seeks a single, unified means for the staff to search across multiple data sources through a simple Web-based search form and an associated results page. This will improve the agency's efficiency in finding information to support its regulatory mission. This searchcapability would not replace more advanced search mechanisms associated with specific datasources, such as ADAMS or SharePoint. Rather, it would enable a broader view of all NRC information.

The NRC foresees a business analysis effort directed at understanding and capturing requirements for an internal unified search approach. Under this subtask the Contractor shall:

1) Facilitate a series of focus sessions on what unified search means, who are the stakeholders, what are the reasons for conducting such a result, and what would be the end state;

2) Analyze the results of the sessions to categorize or otherwise characterize what

3) Provide a final presentation that documents the approach, analysis, and requirements.

Each step will contain a checkpoint to ensure that the activities and outputs are aligned with IRSD/expectations. Our experience has shown us that this approach improves the quality of the outputs and the realization of benefits from the efforts.

In addition to the primary project phases, the Contractor shall participate in various project related activities, such as communication and activity facilitation, will be performed throughout the course of the project.

NRC BAPM analysts will assist in analyzing and documenting the requirements for a Internal Unified Search method. The intent is to provide the requirements definition that will be the foundation for subsequent work on this project (e.g., technology alternatives analysis; project plan; implementation). In addition, the Contractor shall perform the following:

## 1) Perform Business Analysis

- Establish Project Goal & Objectives
- Facilitate discussions with staff stakeholders
- Analyze Business Activities & Information
- Develop Requirements

## 2) Establish Analysis Project Plan

Establish Analysis Project Plan with the NRC IRSD/IMB/CMS team to establish key milestones, facilitation approach, and finalize deliverables. Obtain background documentation, develop a strawman depiction, and understand overall mission and objectives.

- Conduct Facilitation Sessions with key stakeholders to document business activities, decision points, information sources, and individuals/offices involved; elicit ideas. Four such sessions are anticipated.
- Characterize the Search Environment, based on the input from the facilitation sessions.
- Review results with IRSD/IMB/CMS team. Provide a highlevel review with key stakeholders to validate.
- Draft and Deliver Requirements, including non-functional requirements, and review with IRSD/IMB/CMS team.

- Establish Analysis Project Plan Week 1
- Conduct Facilitation Sessions Week 2
- Characterize Search Environment Week 4
- Draft and Deliver Requirements Week 7 & 8

The Contractor shall work with the NRC to reach an agreement on project approach.
