

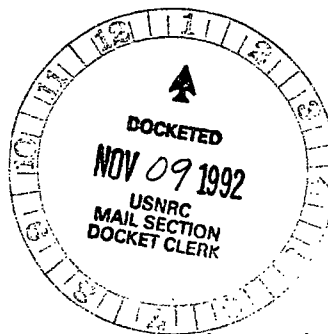

Pursuant to our November 3, 1992 telephone conversation with Mr. Ed Hawkins of your office, and in light of the ANPRM published in the October 28, 1992 Federal Register proposing revisions to Appendix A of 10 CFR 40, Power Resources, Inc. (PRI) wishes to withdraw our license amendment request dated May 6, 1992 requesting a partial exemption of the long-term surveillance fee for our proposed by-product material disposal site. It is our intent at this time to pursue resolution of this issue through the public comment process provided by the above referenced ANPRM. Should this avenue not prove satisfactory, PRI will again consider approaching the URFO directly concerning this matter.
