The Department of Health Office of Radiation Protection Technical Comments on  
Draft Report – Integrated Materials Performance Evaluation Program Review of  
Washington Agreement State Program – May 6-10, 2013

Page 1, 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph, 2<sup>nd</sup> line, “Environmental Health” should be “Environmental Public Health.”

Page 2, 4<sup>th</sup> paragraph, 7<sup>th</sup> line, “Environmental Radiation Monitoring and Assessment Section” should be “Environmental Sciences Section.”

Page 2, 5<sup>th</sup> paragraph, 10<sup>th</sup> line, insert “(now Environmental Sciences)” before “Section.”

Page 8, 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph, 3<sup>rd</sup> line, there are two periods at the end of the sentence.

Page 8, 4<sup>th</sup> paragraph, last line, there are two periods at the end of the sentence.

Page 11, Section 4.2.3, 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph, recommend adding “(See Appendix E, starting on page E.3)” at the end of the first sentence.

Page 12, 4<sup>th</sup> paragraph, 3<sup>rd</sup> line, replace “Environmental Radiation Monitoring and Assessment Section” with “Environmental Sciences Section.”

Pages E.1 – E.3, several of the license numbers have the format of “WA-WN-XXXX.” There is no “WA” in Washington’s license numbers. For example, in File No.: 1, License No.: “WA-WN-I0431” should be “WN-I0431.”
