The Draft RIS looks very good, and Region I is in general agreement with the content. We have two comments for your consideration:

- 1. The RIS discusses transfers but does not appear to address a time constraint on how long a source can be kept at the temporary job site before being returned without reporting. Perhaps the document should also reference that reporting is not be required even if a radiography licensee provides notification for storage at a temporary jobsite for >180 days IAW 34.101(c).
- 2. Should the RIS address the following scenario? An Agreement State licensee, who also possesses an NRC licensee, transfers a source from the Agreement State License to the NRC license for temporary work under the NRC license. After a few days, the company returns the source back to the Agreement State license. In this example, does the licensee have to report a transfer if the possession is less than one day? OR What if it exceeds several days?
