Dear Todd Campbell:

This is in reference to NRC Form 314 dated June 17, 2013, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 07-11871-06, Docket No. 03033438. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. You are currently licensed to possess a cesium sealed source. Please provide documentation that any sealed source possessed by this authorization was transferred to a person licensed to possess this source, or state that you did not possess any sealed sources under this license.
2. You submitted a survey, but did not submit a diagram showing where the survey was taken. Please submit a diagram corresponding to the survey.
3. The survey did not submit enough information to ensure the area was surveyed appropriately. Please comment on the depth of the survey as compared to the simplified survey procedures described in NUREG-1757, Volume 1, Figure 8.1. <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1757/v1/sr1757v1r2.pdf> or perform another survey as stated in the simplified survey.
4. Please provide the last inventory of materials possessed performed after the last receipt of materials, which show the activity and the current date.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office and refer to Mail Control No. 581231. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.
