This is to inform the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that Strathmore Minerals has determined that it will not submit a license application for its proposed Gas Hills heap leach facility in Fremont County, Wyoming by December 2013 as indicated in its Letter of Intent (LOI) of January 23, 2013. Strathmore is reevaluating the project and has not identified a future date to submit the application. Strathmore will advise NRC of its future plans upon completion of its evaluation.
