On June 7, 2013, the NRC issued Regulatory Issue Summary 2013-06, *Preparation and Scheduling of Operator Licensing Examinations*, which requests the voluntary submittal of information regarding future licensing examinations for operators. In response to that request, Duke Energy Progress, Inc., formerly known as Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L), is submitting the proposed operator licensing examination schedule for calendar years 2015 through 2018, for the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant (BSEP), Unit Nos. 1 and 2.
