Ms. Santiago, since you only need the Radiation Safety Committee to meet once a year, it would appear that you do not need a broad scope program. Ms. Santiago told me that now have only one active principal investigator and the use of one sealed source. I recommend that they amend their license to a limited scope license so that they would not have requirements for a Radiation Safety Committee as they did seem to need a broad scope program. I discussed the differences and told her to review NUREG-1556, Volume 7. She would review and discuss with the Radiation Safety Officer who was away on vacation.

Action Required: The licensee will review and discuss when the Radiation Safety Officer is back after August 8.
