The purpose of this letter is to address the request for additional information (RAI) identified in the NRC e-mail correspondence to UniStar Nuclear Energy, dated December 2, 2010 (Reference 1). This RAI addresses Foreign Ownership, Control, or Domination (FOCD), as discussed in Part 1, Introduction and Interfaces, of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 9.

Reference 2 indicated that a revised response to this RAI would be provided by November 30, 2013. Subsequent industry developments in the area of 10 CFR 50.38, 'Ineligibility of Certain Applicants' and FOCD, specifically the issuance of a U.S. NRC Staff Requirements Memorandum SECY-12-0168, requesting a fresh assessment on issues related to foreign ownership, domination, or control, with the establishment of an interim milestone date of December 31, 2013 for development of a voting paper for Commission review, warrants a reschedule of this UniStar RAI 281 response date.

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UniStar Nuclear Energy intends to develop an updated response to RAI 281 within three months following the NRC Commission approval and issuance of any revised 10 CFR 50.38, Standard Review Plan (SRP), and/or FOCD guidance.


