SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 030-38333/2013-001 AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION, YALE UNIVERSITY AND YOUR LETTER DATED JULY 25, 2013

Dear Dr. Spangler:

This letter refers to your July 25, 2013, correspondence, in response to our June 28, 2013, letter.

The Notice of Violation enclosed with our June 28, 2013, letter cited one violation which was identified by the NRC during an inspection at the Yale University PET Research Center in New Haven, Connecticut. (Inspection Report No. 030-38333/2013-001). The violation involved the failure to maintain the inventory of licensed materials with half-lives greater than 120 days to those quantities for which a prescribed amount of financial assurance was provided. The violation was classified as Severity Level IV.

You disputed the violation and described the basis for your dispute. NRC is in the process of reviewing the basis of your dispute and will notify you of the results of our review when the review has been completed.
