On July 2, 2013, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a focused Problem Identification and Resolution inspection at your Indian Point Energy Center (IPEC), Units 2 and 3. The inspection covered one or more of the key attributes of the security cornerstone of the NRC's Reactor Oversight Process. The enclosed inspection report documents the inspection results which were discussed on July 2, 2013, with Mr. Patric Conroy, Nuclear Safety Assurance Director, and other members of your staff.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your licenses as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your licenses. The inspectors reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel.

No findings were identified during this inspection.
