7/30/2013 (10:38) Ms. Kovats called and left a message on my voice-mail requesting an update on the progress of the acceptance of the Trust Fund. (11:10) I returned Ms. Kovat's call. I stated that I had reviewed the Trust Fund Agreement and the only problem I had was in Section 6. The financial institution had removed the two exceptions which limited the types of financial instruments that the financial institution could use to fund the trust. Securities or other obligations need to be securities or obligations of the Federal or State government. Time or demand deposits needed to be insured by an agency of the Federal government and in obligations of the Federal government. State and Municipal bonds needed to be rated BBB or higher by Standard & Poor's or Baa or higher by Moody's Investment Services. Ms. Kovat's stated that she had looked over the model wording in NUREG-1757 (page A-46 and A-47) and understood the issue better. The model wording would be provided to the licensee's financial people who would speak to the representatives of the financial institution. If there should be continued problems with finding acceptable wording for all parties, Ms. Kovat's requested a conference call. I agreed that a conference call would be appropriate in that circumstance.
