Dear Colonel Fota:

This letter refers to the inspection that was conducted on July 2, 2013, by NRC staff at the Walter Reed Army Medical Center (WRAMC)/Diamond Ordnance Radiation Facility (DORF), Forest Glen Annex, in Silver Spring, Maryland. The results of this inspection will be used to support WRAMC's request for termination of the NRC license for the facility. During this inspection, the inspector toured the facility and met with Michael Borisky of the Army Research Laboratory and David Burton of the Walter Reed National Military Medical Center who provided information on the history of radioactive material use at the facility, the scope of the decommissioning activities, and radiological surveys that were conducted. The inspector confirmed that radioactive waste and associated storage equipment (i.e. shelves, refrigerators, and freezers), previously located at the facility under the WRAMC license, were no longer present in the WRAMC/DORF. The results of this inspection were discussed with you at the conclusion of the inspection on July 17, 2013.

This letter forwards NRC Form 591 Part 1, "Safety Inspection Report and Compliance Inspection," indicating that no items of non-compliance were found during the above described inspection. Please retain the form in your files. No acknowledgment of this letter is required.
