Shaw Environmental and Infrastructure, Inc. (a CB&I Company) intends to perform licensed work activities at the following location on July 25, 2013:

Bed Bath & Beyond Store 1006 Green Ridge Square, 3410 Alpine Avenue NW Walker, MI 49544

Response activities will consist of collection of smear samples to assess potential levels of tritium contamination and decontamination activities associated with one potentially damaged tritium exit sign. Based on experience at similar sites, potential removable tritium contamination levels are expected to be above Regulatory Guide 1.86 levels. All wastes from the sampling and decontamination activities will be secured at the site and packaged along with the damaged sign for shipment back to the sign manufacturer.
