Possession limit change needed for Subitem 8.C on the license

SUMMARY

NRC now needs to modify the possession limit on this license so that one total possession limit is listed, that includes iodine-131, and all other materials authorized under 10 CFR 35.300.

We cannot continue authorizing "As needed (not to exceed one curie of I-131)," or similarly worded limits.

The revised authorization should not have to be broken out by radionuclide and it is best if it is not.

For example, you may request "Total activity not to exceed two curies," or something similar. Your request should be realistic for your needs, include room for growth and accommodate waste streams.

Please advise us of the possession limit you wish to have.

In addition, please provide the email address, direct telephone number and fax number for the RSO on this license, Dr. Carole Roseland. My attempts to reach her by telephone on July 15, 2013, were unsuccessful and we had no other quick means to contact her. Her phone number rang without a voicemail pickup. I also noted that we do not have a telephone number listed for you,
