In NRC Form 314 'Certificate of Disposition' dated April 9, 2013, and letters dated June 17, 2013, and July 15, 2013 you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.
