### SUMMARY

This refers to your license renewal application dated January 18, 2013, and the phone conversation between Jeff Harter and Jennifer Bishop on May 16, 2013.

1. In reviewing your license renewal application, you stated that there have been no changes to your license since the last amendment (Amendment No. 10), so an application was not necessary. However, there have been changes to the program since your last license renewal. Because of these changes, we ask that a new application be submitted using the guidance from NUREG-1556, Volume 4, 'Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program- Specific Guidance about Fixed Gauge Licenses.'

3. In the list of devices you have provided, you did not include any Texas Nuclear devices with a Model No. 5197. In addition, for the Ohmart Model No. ED-2 device, we will need to know the model number for the sealed source.

**Response: Please confirm if you would like to maintain the Texas Nuclear Model No. 5197 device on your license. If you do not plan to keep this device on your license, please provide the documentation that any devices you have possessed have been properly disposed of. For the Ohmart Model No. ED-2 device, please provide the sealed source model number.**

4. In addition, the total possession limit for Cs-137 on your license currently is 1,520 millicuries, which is higher than the amount listed in your application.

**Response: Please state the total possession limit you will require.**


