Dr. Erickson is authorized for the items listed below:

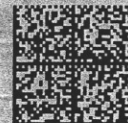
- 902 KAR 100:072 section 30: Use of unsealed radioactive material for uptake, dilution, and excretion studies for which a written directive is not required.
