Jay Collins completed his review of the draft NUREG/CR. Congratulations, he was very impressed! There should be relatively minor changes and revisions expected. There is a good chance that this report will be sent to the Advisory Committee for Reactor Safety for review. They have been placing emphasis on justification of major assumptions and addressing of uncertainties and sensitivities.
