I am writing you to provide the additional information as requested in your email to Leanne Farr of our office dated July 30, 2013.

1. We do not require an authorization to possess and use radioactive materials as we are not doing PET scans.
2. There are no above or below storage areas as we are occupying a single story building slab on grade.
3. Please see attached certification from both parties allowing access to our new location for the purpose of decontamination or removal of licensed material.
4. All commitments, including procedures, and equipment used for radiation protection currently in place at 520 Saybrook Road, will remain in place at our new location at 420 Saybrook Road.

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
Dear Mr. Gallagher:

Please be advised that the undersigned, Middlesex Cardiology Associates, P.C. ("MCA"), as Tenant, and Medical Development Associates, LLC ("MDA"), as Landlord, are parties to a lease agreement dated April 29, 2013 (the "Lease"). The leased premises consist of approximately 16,000 square feet of space on the first floor in a building located at 520 Saybrook Road, Middletown, Connecticut (the "Leased Premises").


