

SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT

SUMMARY

By letter dated July 26, 2013, Transnuclear, Inc. (TN) requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9255 for the Model No. NUHOMS® MP187 multi-purpose cask. TN did not request any changes to the package design, or operating procedures, acceptance tests and maintenance program of the package. The certificate has been renewed for an additional five year period.

EVALUATION

By letter dated July 26, 2013, Transnuclear, Inc. (TN) requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9255 for the Model No. NUHOMS® MP187 multi-purpose cask. TN did not request any changes to the package design, or operating procedures, acceptance tests and maintenance program of the package. The staff reviewed the package application dated August 4, 2003, as supplemented on September 16, 2008, in support of the renewal request and determined that the documentation was available and complete.

CONDITIONS

The following changes have been made to the certificate of compliance:

Condition No. 8 was reworded to clarify that fissile material is not authorized for air transport since the package was not evaluated per the requirements of 10 CFR 71.55(f).

A new Condition No. 10 was added to state that fabrication of new packagings is not authorized. The package is currently limited by the provisions of 10 CFR 71.19(c). This regulation applies to a package with a -85 designation in the certificate's identification number and requires that all fabrication of this packaging must have been completed by December 31, 2006. TN would therefore need to apply for a -96 designation in the certificate's identification number to fabricate and use new packages. To address this regulatory requirement, Condition No. 10 was included in the certificate of compliance. As a consequence of the inclusion of the new Condition No. 10, the previous Condition No. 10 was renumbered No.11.

Condition No. 11 of the certificate reflects the new expiration date of November 30, 2018.

The references section has been updated to include this renewal request.

CONCLUSION

The certificate has been renewed for a five year term. These changes do not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
