Ladies and Gentlemen:

By letter dated February 23, 2010, Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) notified the NRC of its intent to utilize its existing 10 CFR Part 50 Quality Assurance Program (QAP) for design, construction, and operation of development of an independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI) under the general license provisions of Part 72, Subpart K, at the Vogle Electric Generating Plant (VEGP). By letter dated November 29, 2010, the NRC issued a meeting notice (ML103330249) for the purpose of discussing SNC's plans for design, construction, and operation of an ISFSI in accordance with the general license provisions at VEGP with NRC Region II on December 15, 2010. A copy of the slide presentation from the December 15, 2010, meeting is available in ADAMS (ML103620570).

The requirements of 10 CFR 72.212(b)(1) include notification of the NRC in accordance with the instructions in 10 CFR 72.4 at least 90 days before the first storage of spent fuel under the general license provisions of Part 72, Subpart K, with the licensee's name, address, reactor license and docket numbers, and the name and means of contacting a person responsible for providing additional information concerning spent fuel under this general license. The purpose of this letter is affirm SNC's previously stated intentions to utilize the general license provisions of Part 72 for additional storage capacity for VEGP Units 1 and 2, and to update the contact information required by 10 CFR 72.212(b)(1).
