Dear Mr. DeLaBarre:

Enclosed is an application (XCOM1270), dated July 9, 2013, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), from Transco Products Inc. for the export of metal reflective thermal insulation to Doosan Heavy Industries & Construction Co., Ltd. in the Republic of Korea (ROK) for ultimate use at the Barakah Nuclear Power Plant (Units 1, 2, 3, and 4) in the United Arab Emirates (UAE).

We understand that the Executive Branch (EB) has accepted generic assurances from the UAE for the export of minor components to the UAE through the ROK, and will soon receive generic assurances from the ROK for similar exports. We would also like to point out that this application will not be approved until the issuance of pending export application XCOM1266, which will satisfy the provision in 10 CFR 110.41(a)(7). Therefore, pending receipt of ROK assurances and issuance of XCOM1266, the NRC intends to issue this license after the 30-day review period.
