General DHS reaction to screening analysis report is that they have concerns about information they believe could be exploited by a potential adversary. We discussed current internal NRC dialog regarding FOIAbility, the existence of similar or identical info already in the public domain, and similar perspectives and aspects.

Action items:

DHS will have their 'classifiers' go through the report and identify all specific info of concern against the criteria they would use to withhold information from the public. They will call Rich next week with status and projected completion date.

George Wilson will contact USACE again and offer to provide them with a copy of the screening analysis and to confirm they are OK with the inclusion of information taken from USACE sources.
