This NRC reg allows licensees and applicants to request protection for largely for financial reasons (similar to a copyright) but there is one provision that speaks to security. We have removed/redacted those parts in the current version of the report. I'll verify though, whether they cited PCII.

Thanks for the updated report. Based on conversations with General Counsel I have two questions:

1. Is the NRC an approved participant in the DHS Protected Critical Infrastructure Information (PCII) Program?
Basically, this requires someone from the NRC being trained and certified by the PCII Program to handle PCII information.
2. If so, did Duke Energy submit critical infrastructure information, in this case the dams information, to the NRC and request that the information be protected under the PCII program?

I will be checking with the PCII Program to see if their records identify the NRC as a certified PCII participant. As soon as I get any info on this end I will let you know.
