SUBJECT: 2014 OPERATIONAL SAFETY REVIEW TEAM MISSION

Dear Mr. Flory:


In 2011, the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) performed an Operational Safety Assessment Review Team (OSART) mission in the United States at the Seabrook Station in New Hampshire. For the upcoming 2014 IAEA OSART mission, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has coordinated with the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations to nominate the Clinton Power Station in Illinois. The enclosure to this letter lists the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations, Clinton Power Station, and NRC contact addresses for the mission.

The NRC supports the IAEA Operational Safety Program of which the OSART program is an important part. The 2014 mission at CPS will be the eighth OSART mission in the United States. As part of its support for the OSART program, the NRC will share costs for the Clinton Power Station OSART mission. This arrangement will be similar to the NRC cost-sharing agreement for the Seabrook mission (reference the NRC-IAEA International Interagency Agreement No. NRC-HQ-11-I-08-0003). We request that the IAEA coordinate the mission schedule

with the Clinton Power Station contact so as to minimize the impact on significant plant activities.
