I am writing to request that Building 118, located at the Pfizer Inc facility in Groton, Connecticut, be released for unrestricted use.

Building 118 is a 750,000 square-foot, five-story research building located on the east side of Eastern Point Road at Pfizer's facility located in Groton, CT. Radioactive materials were used in Building 118 between 1955 and 2012 under radioactive materials license number 06-05869-01.

As licensed operations were discontinued in areas over the years, these areas were assessed and remediated, as necessary, by our on-site technicians from Radcor, LLC of Salem Connecticut. A report provided by Radcor, LLC, which includes all of the sampling data from the many areas assessed in Building 118, is included on a USB flash drive provided with this letter.

The two radiosynthesis areas (D410 and D412) and the monitor area, which contained the hood ducting from these areas, were expected to be more substantially contaminated so the assessment and remediation of these areas was contracted out to Cabrera Services of East Hartford, CT. Cabrera performed this work between April and July of 2013. A copy of Cabrera's final status report is also included on the USB flash drive provided with this letter.

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
