Jim,

NRC Letter dated December 28, 2012 requested Fansteel and FMRI to submit information to the NRC.

Fansteel and FMRI gave you a date of March 22, 2013 to have that information to you. Fansteel and FMRI need more time to confirm all documents and statements have been thoroughly researched to allow Fansteel to extend the primary note to 2023. That said Fansteel and FMRI would like to give you an update on the status of decommission at the Muskogee site.

The Sale agreement with GLA-1 did not go through.

FMRI will not pursue to eliminate the Contingency Note and replace with Insurance policies. The Contingency Note will remain the same.

A draft updated Figure 8.3 with footnotes regarding schedule.

A copy of the Consent Order with the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality which will resolve the outstanding permit issue. This consent Order is in the hands of the ODEQ for modification and according to the last e-mail dated 3/14/2013 from Steven Gunnels should be in the mail shortly.

FMRI has discussed with Energy Fuels ( Formerly International Uranium Corp) to start shipping WIP again. Jo Anne Tischler has confirmed that FMRI has in place the needed documents to continue shipping except for the Contract. They would like for FMRI to submit a new affidavit and any sampling analysis that might have taken place since the last material was shipped (January of 2009) to Dennison Mines to confirm the profile submitted previously. Mr. Harold Roberts is looking at the previous contract and updating the economics.

FMRI is continuing to look at a more economical way to deal with the Caf2 ponds and building and soils

Fansteel and FMRI is requesting 2 extra weeks to submit information about the primary note extension.
