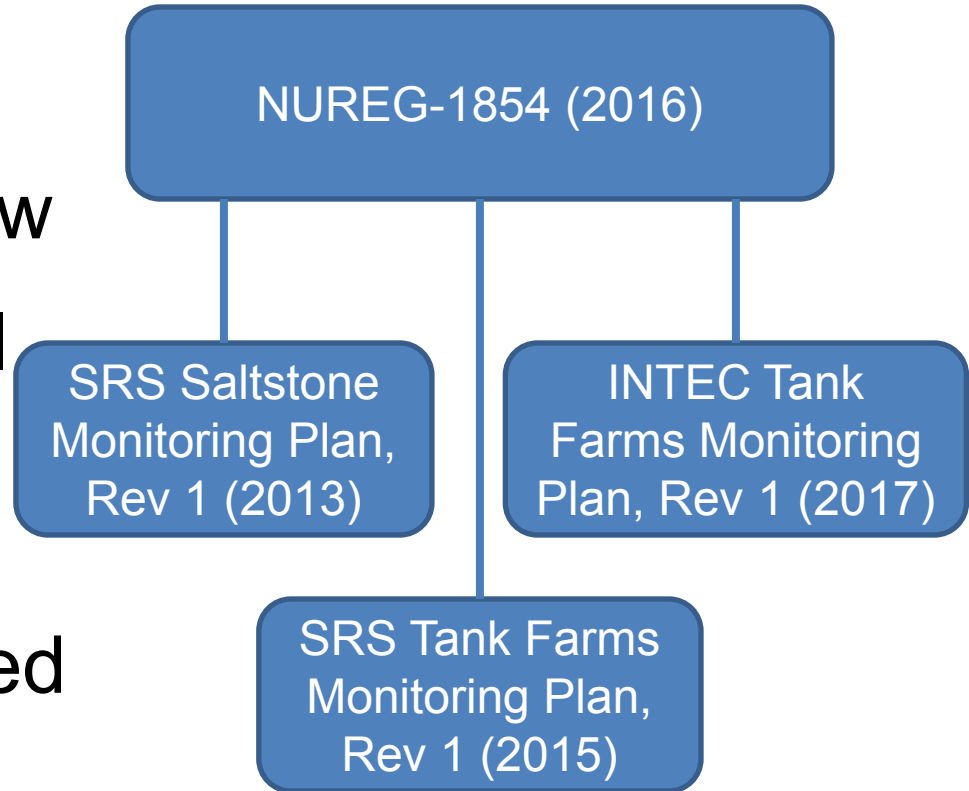
Current Guidance Structure

- General guidance for both consultation and monitoring in NUREG-1854
- Specific Monitoring Plans created for each facility



Future Guidance Structure

- Update to SRS Saltstone Monitoring based on 2012 review
- SRS Tank Farms will be merged into one monitoring plan
- INTEC will be updated when final tanks are closed



Planned Improvements in General Guidance

- Guidance was developed in 2005-2007
- New process (especially monitoring)
- Lessons Learned to be incorporated
- Examples:
 - Clarification on process for Letters of Concern
 - Clarification on coordination with Covered States
 - Consistency changes with current Part 61 rulemaking
- Actual timeline depends on resources



Public Involvement Opportunities

- Dates are approximate as overall activities are driven by budget
- Summer 2014, NRC meeting in Aiken, SC to discuss changes to general monitoring
- Summer 2015, NRC meeting to discuss draft revised NUREG-1854 during public comment period
