During a recent internal audit it came to our attention that one of our generally licensed nuclear devices was omitted from our specific license when they were added to it. We currently have a Texas Nuclear 5201 Device registry number TX0634D138B on site as well. The current device is 10 mCi. The device registry allows 200 mCi per device therefore we would like to add 210 mCi to our existing license in order to allow us to add another one of these gauges without going thru the process of amending the license again.
