To Whom It May Concern:

I am the Radiation Safety Officer for Industrial Dynamics Company, Ltd. (IDC), and have been delegated the responsibility of reviewing the described reports herein, which is sought to be withheld, and have been authorized to apply for its withholding. I am familiar with competitive practices in the market for products etc., containing nuclear sealed sources licensed by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

IDC is required by Title 10 CFR 32.52 to submit reports of the distribution of Generally Licensed devices to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and individual Agreement States every calendar quarter, listing the names and addresses of each client to whom authorized devices are transferred to and licensees from whom we receive them. Additional information about the device, such as isotope, quantity and model number is also provided.

IDC is the sole owner of the information provided in the reports described above. To the best of my knowledge, the information, as presented, is not currently available in public sources. IDC customarily treats this type of information as confidential. The company considers lists of active customers and information relevant to commercial transactions to be proprietary.


Examples of information considered by IDC as proprietary information are customer lists and shipments details. Such information, if made available and is used by our competitors, would provide direct tunnels, inroads/intrusion into our marketplaces. This would provide our competitors a head start and marked economic advantage and thus adversely impact the well-being of our business.

Additionally, a significant part of IDC is supported by continuing services. A number of independent entities in USA and abroad could use the information in these device transfer reports including the customer list to enter our market space.

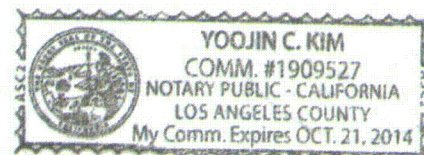
The information we are requesting to be withheld from public is all data printed in transfer report pages with headings of "Transfers of devices to and from General Licensees."

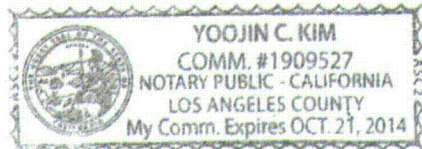
