

	<p>The licensee is authorized to export a cumulative total of 36,000.0 kilograms uranium-235 contained in 720,000.0 kilograms natural uranium and uranium enriched to 5.0 w/o maximum, as uranium dioxide (UO₂), in various forms.</p> <p>The license is amended to: 1) Increase the quantity of low-enriched uranium authorized for export from 20,500.0 kilograms (kg) of uranium-235 (U-235) contained in 420,000.0 kg uranium to a new cumulative total of 36,000.0 kg of U-235 contained in 720,000.0 kg uranium; and 2) extend the expiration date from September 3, 2014 to July 31, 2018.</p> <p>All other conditions remain the same.</p>
