By letter dated June 22, 2011, Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon) submitted an application pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 54 (10 CFR Part 54), to renew Operating Licenses NPF-39 and NPF-85 for Limerick Generating Station, Units 1 and 2 (LGS) for review by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC or the staff). This letter is to inform you of a change in the environmental review schedule for the LGS license renewal review.

Enclosed is the NRC staff's revised environmental review schedule for the LGS license renewal application.
